RE

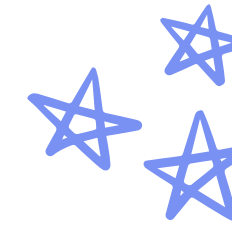
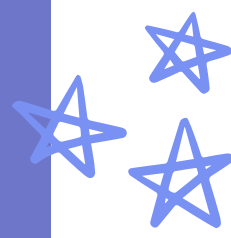
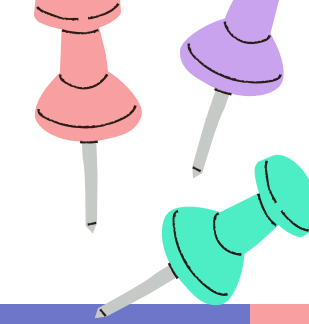
In RE, our unit this half term will focus on Incarnation. We will study the Nativity story and how this guides Christian's beliefs and actions at Christmas time.

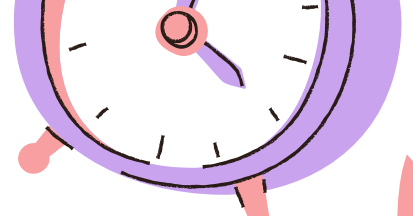
DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY
