In English we will be studying the poem, The Jabberwocky by Lewis Carroll. Next, Philip Pullman's 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' will be used as a stimulus to describe a jungle setting.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be spending time on numbers within 1000 to ensure we are all secure on this knowledge before moving into 10,000s. We will then begin working on addition and subtraction.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we are undertaking fieldwork of the local area. This will include using compass points to give directions, interpreting orienteering and ordnance survey maps, and gathering and comparing meteorological data.

RE

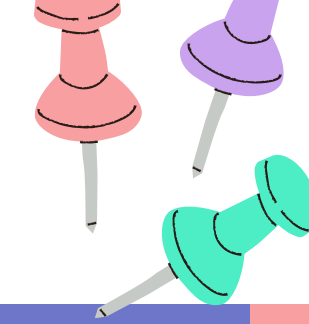
In RE, our unit this half term is on 'Journeys.' We will be looking a range of religions and observing how each one see life as a journey.

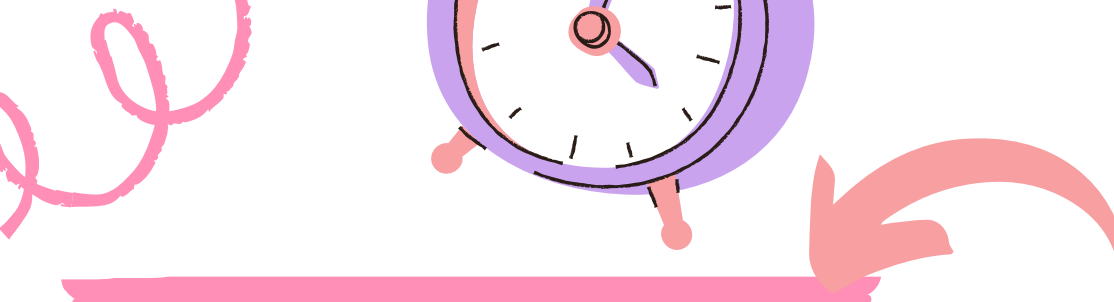
ART AND DESIGN

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PE

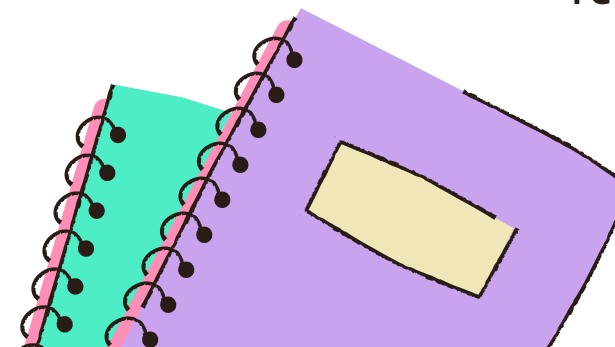
In PE, we will be participating in both football and world games. The latter includes playing a range of unique sports from different countries.

MUSIC

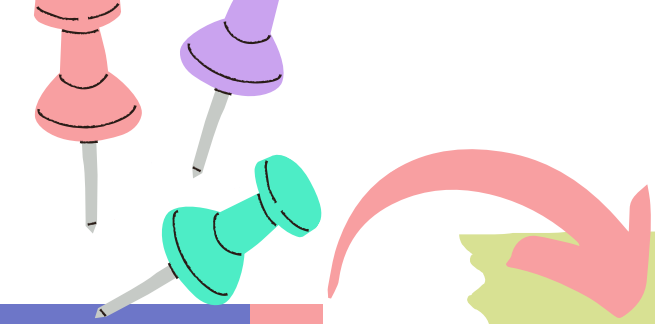
In Music this half term, our unit is focused on composition. We will be revising and using musical notation, and composing our own pieces

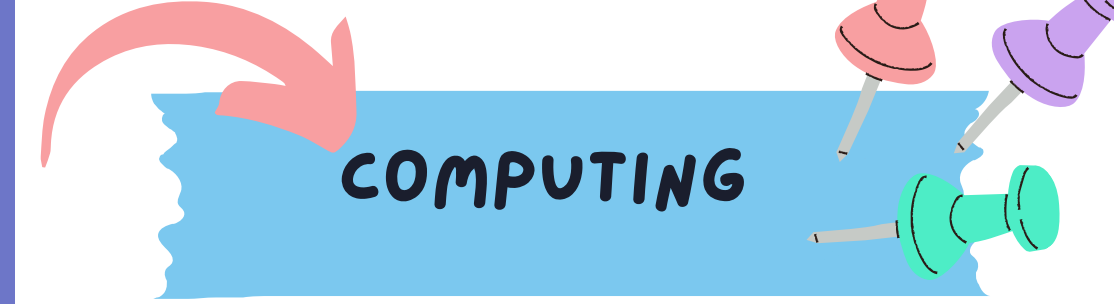


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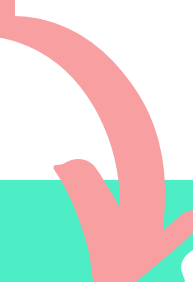
PSHCE
