



ENGLISH

In English this term, we will be studying 'The Adventures of Odysseus' which links to our History unit of work. We will be composing an extra episode to the adventure as well as writing a persuasive piece advertising either Sparta or Athens as the perfect place to live.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be exploring area. We use squares and half-squares to create polygons of a given area and to compare shapes. As well as this, we will be spending some time on multiplication and division – including plenty of practice of times table facts.

HISTORY

In History, we will be learning all about Ancient Greece. We will looking to answer our enquiry question: How have the Ancient Greeks influenced our lives today?

RE

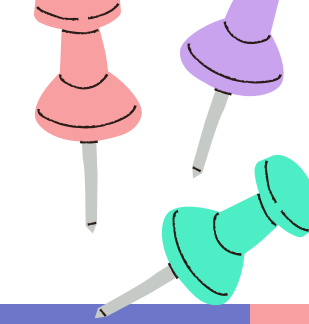
In RE, our unit this is exploring why Christmas is important to Christians. This will involve looking at famous artwork and analysing Christmas Carols.

PE

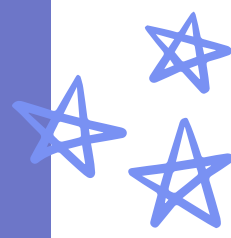

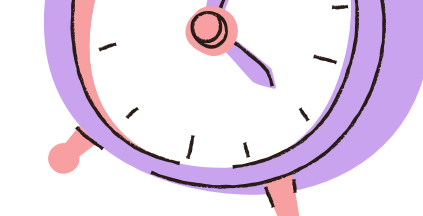
DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

YEAR 4 AUTUMN 2 CURRICULUM FLYER



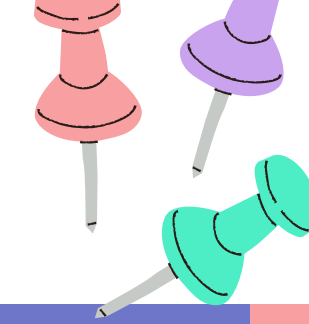


MUSIC
