



ENGLISH

In English this half term we are studying Macbeth by William Shakespeare. We will be rewriting the opening scene as a narrative as well as writing a literary essay exploring how Macbeth's character changes throughout the play.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be exploring place value with numbers up to 1,000,000. This will include rounding, comparing and as well as looking at Roman Numerals. We will then begin securing our understanding of the column method for addition and subtraction.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we will be studying the home nations. This will include exploring the key human and physical features of the UK and looking at some of our key geographical concepts such as population, land-use and locational knowledge.

RE

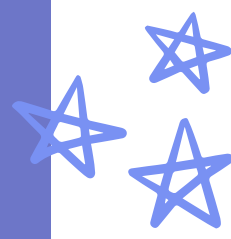
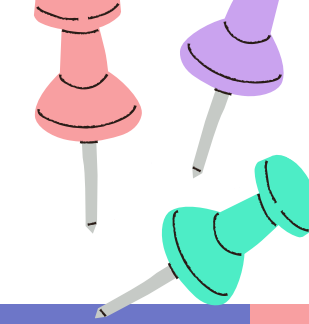
In RE, our unit this half term is all on Christianity. During this unit, pupils will explore the teachings of Jesus particularly around forgiveness and loving our enemies.

SCIENCE

In Science, our topic this half term is on forces. We will be exploring the force of gravity, the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction as well as investigating the impact of mechanisms such as levers, pulleys and gears.

ART AND DESIGN

In Art & Design we will be exploring the work of Van Gogh. We will then create our own landscape painting using a wash and acrylics inspired by his work.

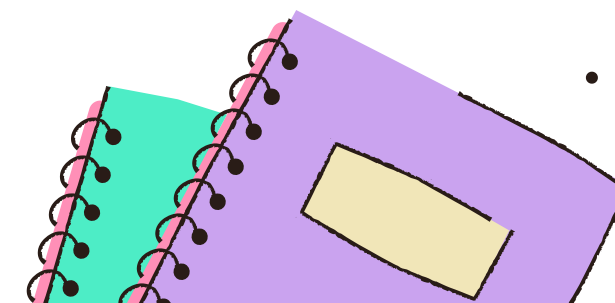
PE

MUSIC

In Music this half term, we will be reading music, composing our own melodies and performing them to the group.



HOW CAN PARENTS HELP AT HOME?

In Computing, pupils will create a non-linear presentation with hyperlinks to and from a 'menu' page using PowerPoint. They will also develop the plan, do, test and modify approach to Computing.

In Spanish, we will be exploring the geography of Spain – looking at key towns and cities. We will also be learning how to give directions in Spanish.
