



ENGLISH

In English this term, we will be studying 'Beowulf.' Pupils will use this as a stimulus to write their own epic poem as well as writing a persuasive letter from the point of view of a character in the poem.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be exploring multiplication and division—particularly looking at multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will then move onto fractions, looking at mixed numbers and improper fractions, as well as adding and subtracting fractions.

HISTORY

In History, we will be learning all about the Anglo Saxons. We will be looking to answer our enquiry question: How did the Anglo-Saxons change life in the UK?

RE

In RE this half term we will be continuing to look at Christianity. We will be particularly focusing on the concept of the trinity and the importance of Christmas to Christians.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

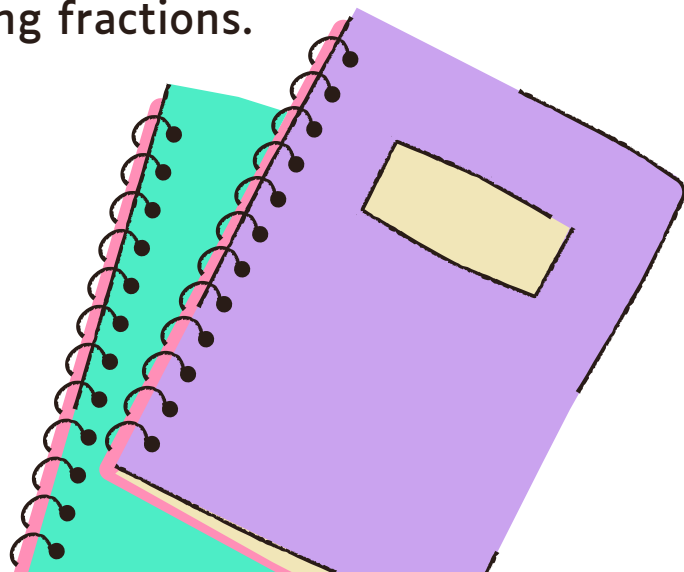
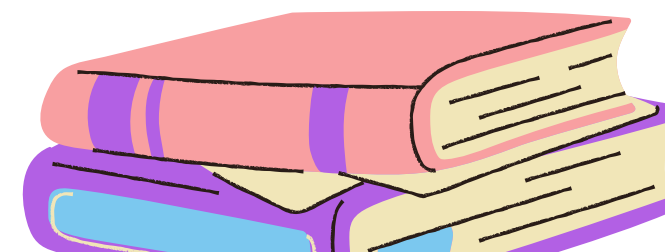
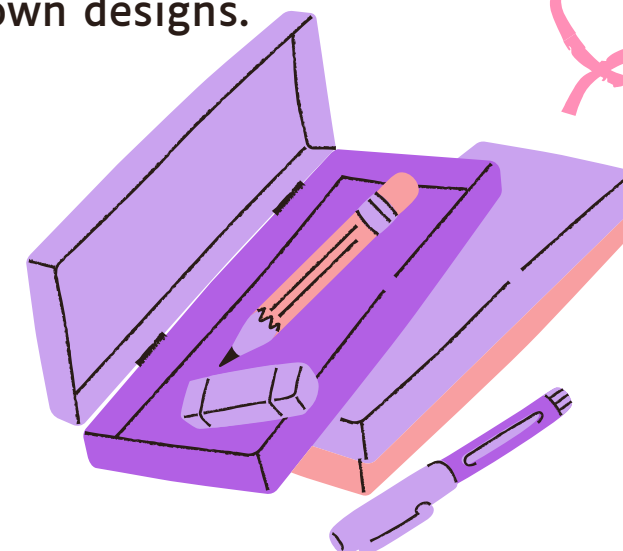
In DT, we will be planning, making and evaluating our very own Christmas themed felt decorations. This will include learning new stitching techniques and applying them to our own designs.

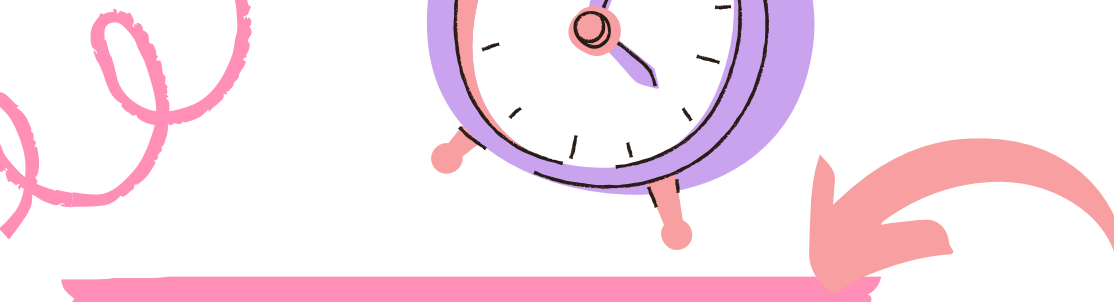
SCIENCE

PE

MUSIC
