



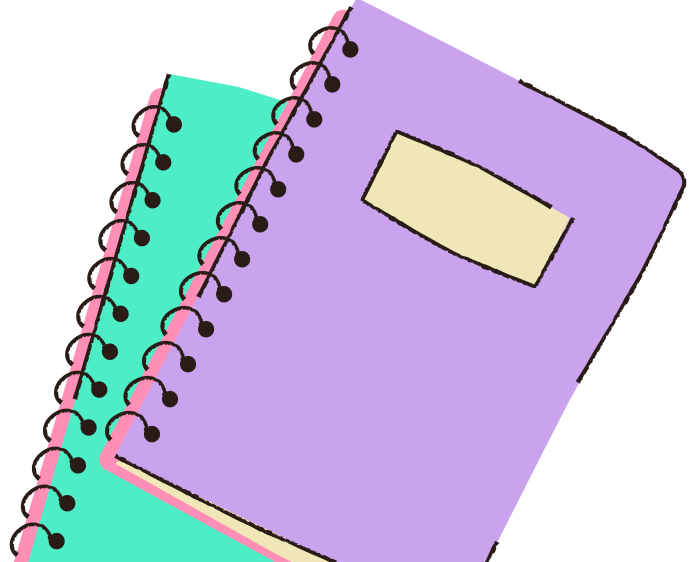
ENGLISH

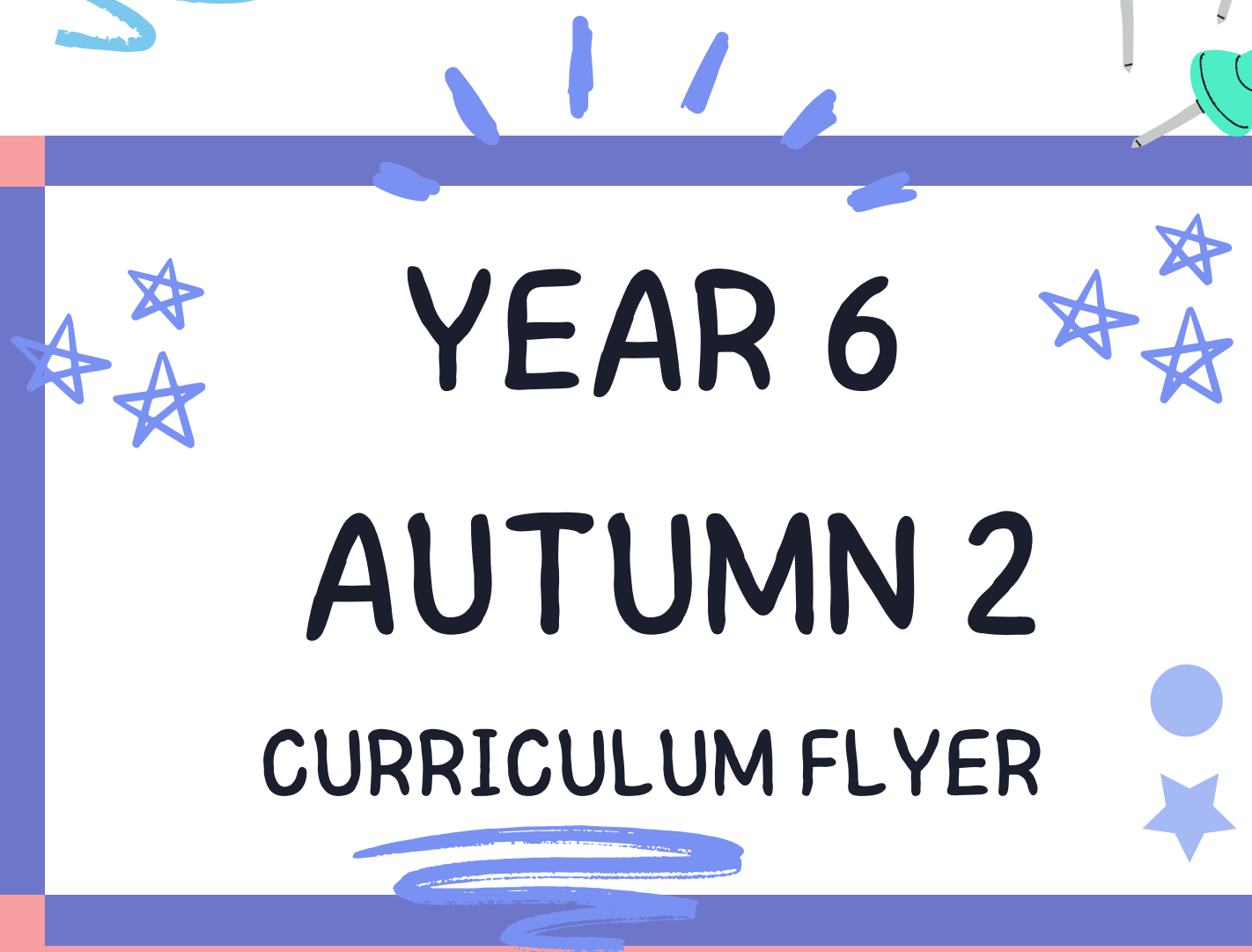
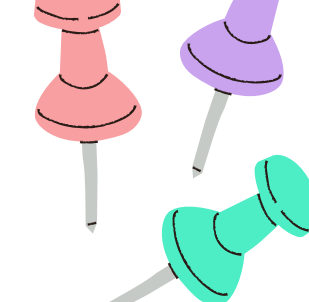
MATHS

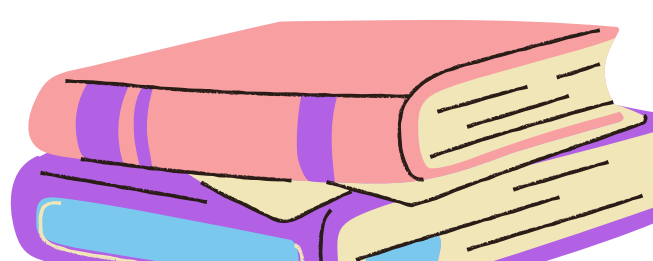

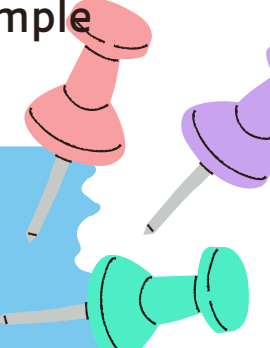
RE

In RE this half term we will be exploring why Christians believe that Jesus was the Messiah and linking this to what we believe the true meaning of Christmas really is.



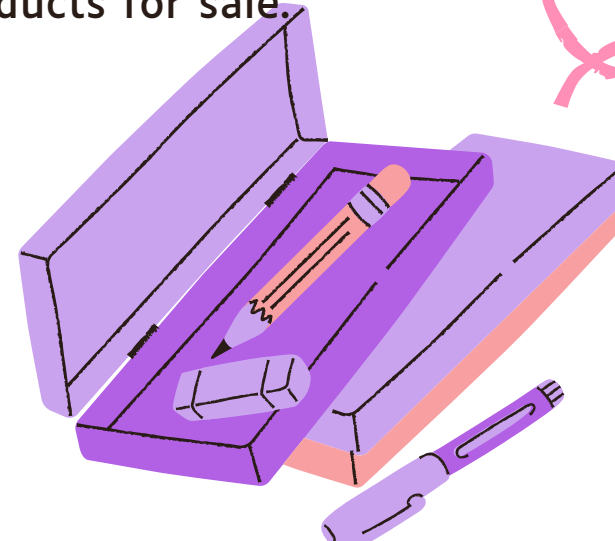
SCIENCE

PE

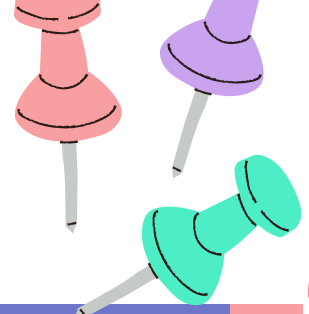

HOW CAN PARENTS HELP AT HOME?

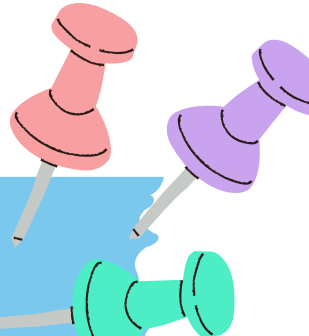

PSHCE

In PSHE this half term we will be continuing to explore relationships. This will include expressing opinion and respecting other points of view, including discussing topical issues.



COMPUTING
