



Half Termly Curriculum Overview Year 6/ Spring 2

English	Maths
In Writing, we are studying 'Goodnight Mister Tom.' We will be writing a balanced report regarding whether evacuation was a positive or negative experience. The children will also be given the opportunity to complete a piece of writing of their choice – a chance to show off their creativity and flair!	In Maths, we will be broadening our understanding of decimal numbers, before moving on to fractions and percentages. Finally, we will be studying area, perimeter and volume. We will also be revising all of our re previous units in readiness for the end of KS2 SATs tests.

Art	History
In Art this term, we are studying Architecture. We will learn how to draw with perspective and explore famous architects from around the world.	In History, we will be studying World War II and particularly the impact it had on our local area of Nottingham.

PSHE
In PSHE this half term we will be challenging stereotypes; evaluating media sources; influences and attitudes to money as well as looking at financial risks.

PE	Computing
In PE this half term, we will be practising a range of skills in order to play Tag Rugby, and putting our bodies to the test in Drumba.	In Computing, we will be exploring computer networks including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the world wide web and the opportunities they offer. We will also learn how search engines function and understand how search results are selected and ranked.

RE	Spanish
In RE, we will be exploring the question, "Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?" through studying the key events of Holy Week.	In Spanish, we will be learning all about the earth and the environment ending with the pupils creating their own books in Spanish.

Music
This half term in Music, children will be learning the ukulele as a whole class. They will be playing songs and learning new chords.



How you can help at home

As always, we encourage our pupils to read daily and fill in their reading diaries to be checked weekly. 6 Bridges and Parks will have PE on Mondays and Tuesdays; and 6 MLK will have PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays and should come to school dressed in the correct kit on these days.
