Our Home-School Agreement, in line with the school behaviour policy, is designed to support the way in which the members of the school can work together in a positive way.

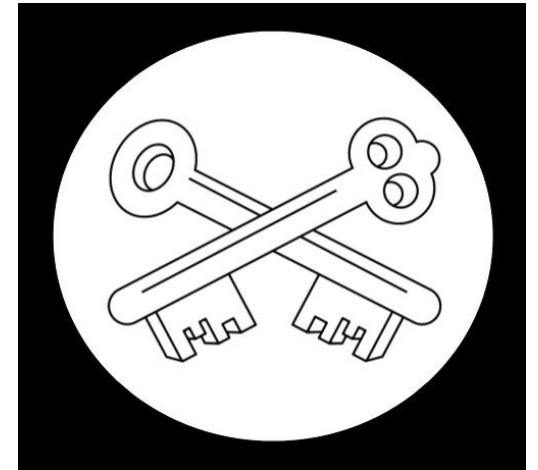
St Peter's aims to promote an environment where all feel happy, safe and secure and our pupils can make the most of their junior school years.
