Dear families of Year 4,

Plans for January – Year 4

I am now in a position to confirm plans for Year 4 from January until our temporary learning village is completed. All year 4 classes will be at Millside Spencer Academy in East Leake.

Millside has asked that our pupils start there on **Tuesday 6th January 2026**, rather than Monday 5th January. We apologise for the inconvenience that this will cause our families but this extra time will ensure everything is in place for our pupils.

Although it is far from ideal, this provision allows for all three classes to be taught by their own class teacher in their own class groups.

Transport:

Pupils will need to arrive outside St Peter's Junior School (Ashworth Avenue) from 8:40am. The bus will depart at 8:45am and arrive in Millside for 9:10am.

At the end of the day, the bus will depart Millside at 3:00pm and arrive back at St Peter's for 3:25pm.

Unfortunately, Millside have asked that pupils are not brought to the school separate to the bus provision.

Lunches:

We are extremely grateful that Millside will be providing hot school dinners for those pupils who would like one. Please book these on ParentPay in the usual way. The cost of these meals will be £3.16.

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Wraparound Care – Casper's

Wraparound care (both Breakfast Club and After-School Club) will also be available for pupils in Year 4. This will be taking place in the Scout Hut located on Ashworth Avenue at the normal Casper's times. All bookings previously made will continue automatically.
