Dear families of Year 5,

Plans for January – Year 5

I am now in a position to confirm plans for Year 5 from January until our temporary learning village is completed. The first day back at school is **Monday 5th January 2026**.

All Year 5 classes will now be at Jesse Gray Primary School in West Bridgford.

Although it continues to be far from ideal, we are delighted that the whole year group team (staff and pupils) will be together in one school.

Transport:

Pupils will need to arrive outside St Peter's Junior School (Ashworth Avenue) from 8:40am. The bus will depart at 8:50am and arrive at the school for 9:00am.

At the end of the day, the bus will depart Jesse Gray at 3:00pm and arrive back at St Peter's for 3:10pm.

Lunches:

We are extremely grateful that Jesse Gray will be providing hot school dinners for those pupils who would like one, please book lunches on ParentPay in the usual way. The cost will be £3.16 per day.

However, Jesse Gray have requested that this starts from week 2 so that they have enough time to arrange this. **As a result, pupils will need to continue to bring packed lunches for the first week please.** Children eligible for free school meals will continue to receive a school provided packed lunch as they have this week.

Wraparound Care – Casper's

Wraparound care (both Breakfast Club and After-School Club) will also be available for pupils in Year 5. This will be taking place in the Scout Hut located on Ashworth Avenue at the normal Casper's times. All bookings previously made will continue automatically.
