

Hello everyone!

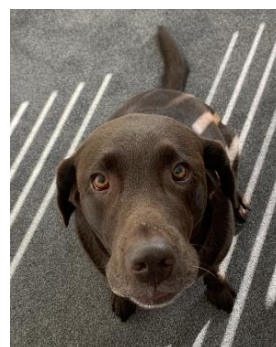
