Dear parent(s),

Every year when we go to Whitby, children inevitably get a headache or suffer from hayfever (even when they've never had it before!). As a result we have had to phone parents to ask for consent to administer Calpol / Piriton. There have been a few occasions in the past when we haven't been able to get in touch with a parent for a few hours and this has meant that a child has not been able to have any medicine to help alleviate their pain.

We are therefore asking for permission from parents, that in our role in loco-parentis we can administer Calpol / Pirition if your child should require it.
