

St Peter's Approach to Art Lessons

RESEARCH AND APPRECIATE 	Lesson 1 Introduction to artist and key image/focus/artistic movement. Share a variety of images presented and key questions as a research base. Introduce and explore key vocabulary when exploring artists work. Single page spread reflections – sharing techniques for creativity to promote developing ownership and independence with this as children progress through school. Share idea/inspiration for final piece of art work at this stage to provide direction and act as a creative stimulus.	Reflect personal views, observations and opinions on the artist's work.
SKETCH 	Lesson 2 Drawing focus – be inspired by a piece of art created by the selected artist. Focus on drawing and sketching skills to explore skills, ideas and techniques inspired by the image.	Reflect on personal achievements in sketching – what areas went well, what improvements could you identify?
EXPLORE AND EXPERIMENT 	Lesson 3 Experimentation with focused skill or element that will be required for next week's project piece. Teach an element or essential skill. Revisit key vocabulary required within unit of work. Allow creativity with varied media: paint, pastel, collage...	How did you find experimenting with the media used? Was it easier/harder than you anticipated? What skills have you developed that will support you in next week's lesson.
INVENT AND CREATE 	Lesson 4 Develop final piece of artwork inspired by the artist and techniques studied. Class teacher to demonstrate through use of WAGOLL generated in front of or alongside the class. (Absorb yourself in the activity alongside the children. It is good for them to see you taking part and being creative.) Provision of sustained period of time on which to focus.	Reflect on the progress made towards the final piece. Successes and areas to prioritise in next lesson.
DEVELOP AND ADAPT 	Lesson 5 Review reflection from previous week. Provision of sustained period of time on which to focus and develop final piece of art work.	Reflect on the progress made. Successes and areas to prioritise in next lesson. Reflect on successes of peers and how ideas could contribute to self-improvement.
REFINE AND EVALUATE 	Lesson 6 Refine and improve final piece of art work. Add finishing touches and evaluate successes. Consider varied media. Record in art sketch book, alongside consideration of how final piece was inspired by the focus artist.	Evaluate your final design.
