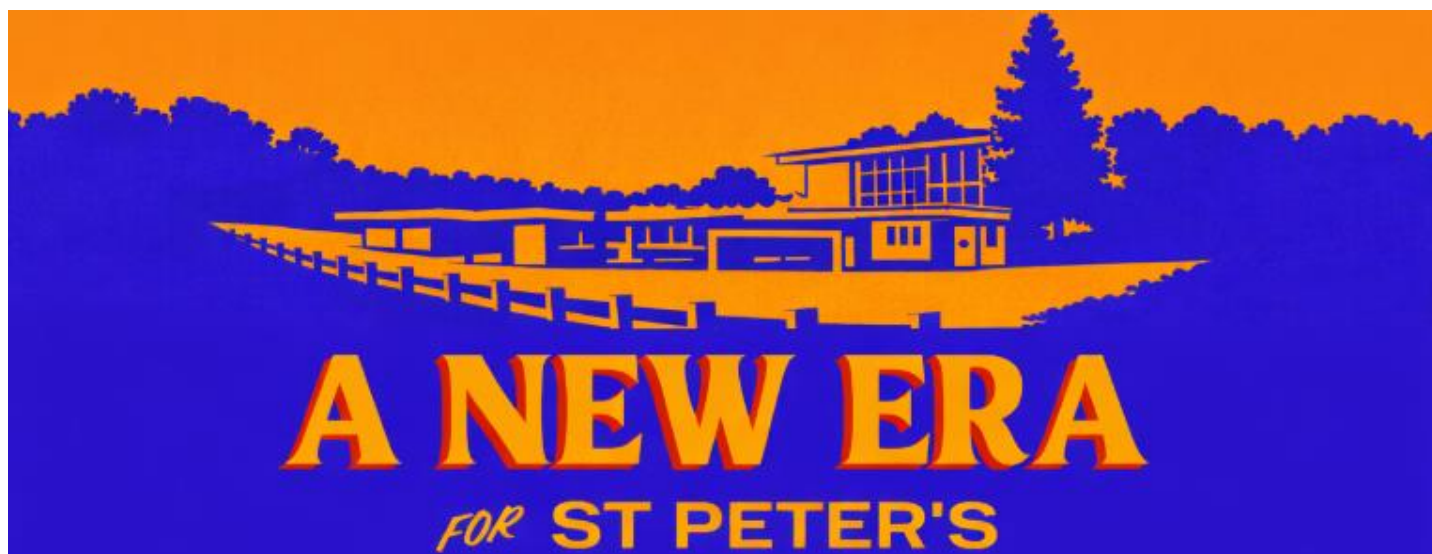

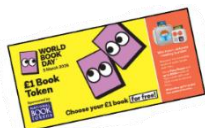
It's that time of year again... World Book Day!

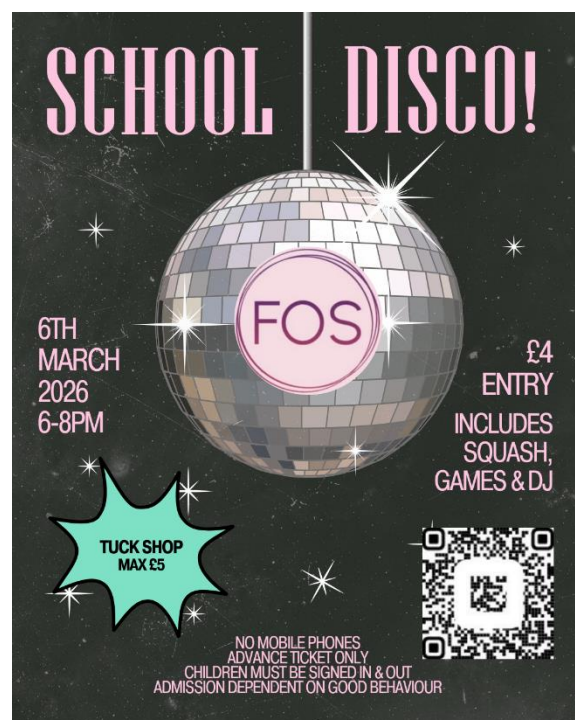
