BUILDING WORKS UPDATE

During the planned replacement and repair of windows and fascia boards around the school, further investigations have taken place on other aspects of the school building. This has resulted in unexpected work needing to be carried out both externally and internally. Unfortunately, this is now expected to be a much longer-term project than previously thought.



The school continues to work closely with Nottinghamshire County Council to ensure that there is minimal disruption to pupils - however, there will continue to be times when classes will need to be temporarily moved to other areas of the school so that building work can be undertaken in those rooms.
