The pupils learnt so much about how keep themselves safe in a variety of situations and all thoroughly enjoyed the experience.

The initiative also gives our Year 5s a taste of leadership and responsibility as they support the youngest members of our school with the transition to life here at St Peter's. Last week, the children played a 'getting to know you' board game, and this week, they took part in a PE session together.

It has been wonderful to see Amigo pairs arranging to meet at break and lunch to play together, without being instructed to do so.
