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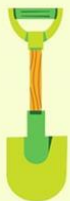

James Peacock was born in Ruddington in 1585 and became a highly successful leather merchant in London. His Will made a gift of a farmhouse to be used as a school and appointed Trustees to manage his legacy which is dedicated to the education of the children of our village.

Today the Trustees continue to manage this and, as a result, all children of Ruddington, when leaving primary school, are eligible to receive a book, geometry set and scientific calculator from the Foundation.
