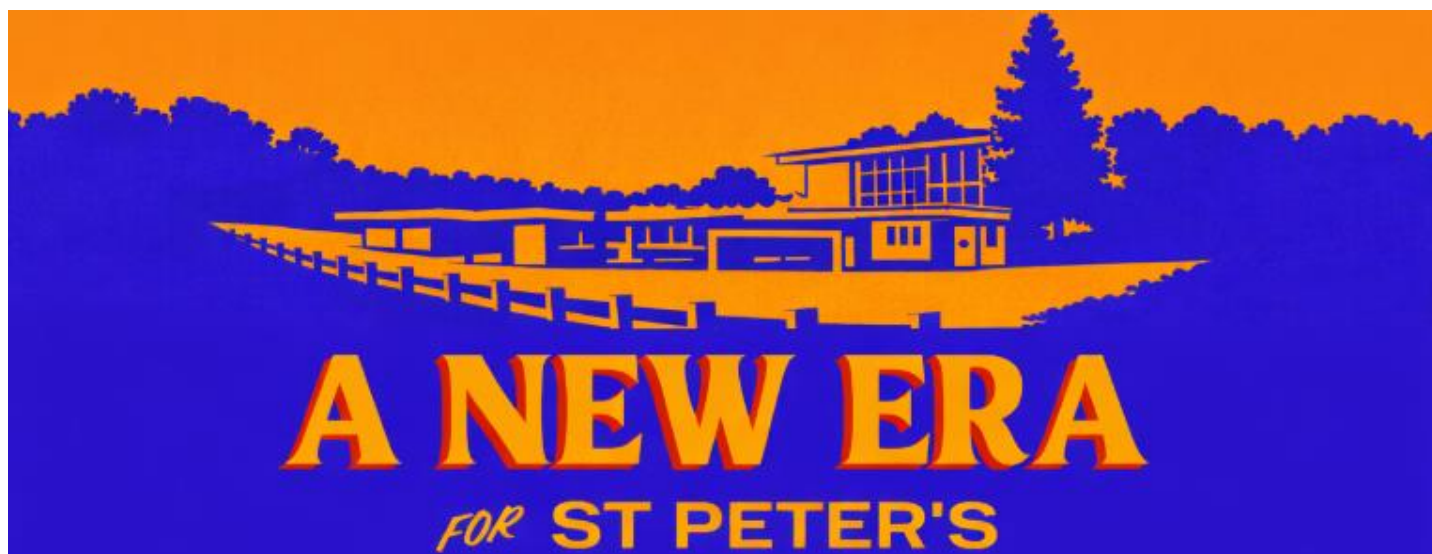

Our friendly staff offer pupils a healthy snack upon arrival at either before- or after-school club, and then the children are provided with toys and games to play with their friends.

After-School Club – 3:30pm to 5:45pm - £9 per child, per session.

On Monday, some of our wonderful Year 4 children headed off to West Bridgford School to take part in an athletics festival, competing against children from across the Rushcliffe area.

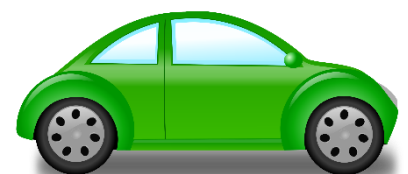
