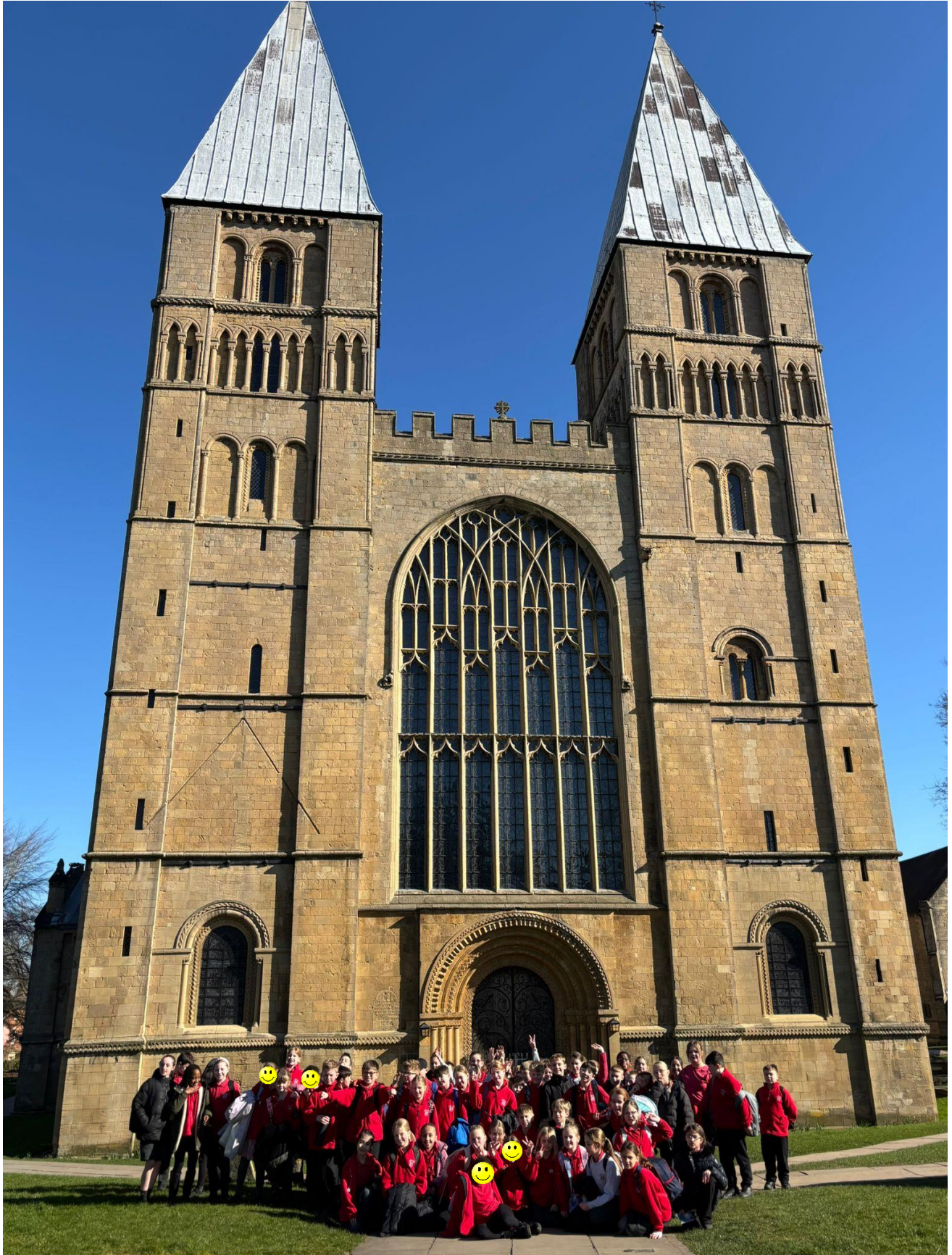
YEAR 4 ATHLETICS FESTIVAL
