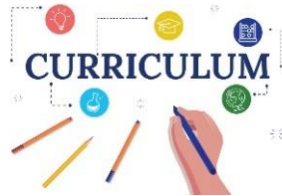

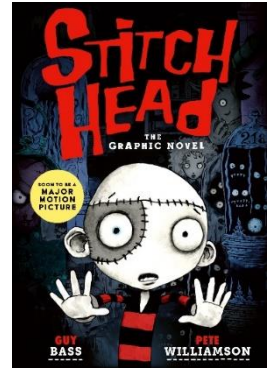

HOLIDAY ACTIVITY AND FOOD (HAF) PROGRAMME

Nottinghamshire County Council is thrilled to announce that funding for the Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) Programme will continue in 2025! This means that children across the county will once again have access to engaging activities and nutritious meals during the school holidays.

Spring (Easter) Holiday Clubs – Bookings Open Soon!

Mark your calendars! From week commencing **10th March 2025**, families can book their places for the Easter holiday clubs. Visit: [Activities and venues | Nottinghamshire County Council](#) to secure a place.

What is HAF?

HAF is a **Department for Education funded programme** that provides **FREE** holiday activities and meals to children who receive benefits-related free school meals. The programme runs during the **Easter, Summer, Autumn (October), and Christmas holidays**.

Who Can Benefit?

- Children aged **5 – 16 years** (Reception aged 4 and Year 11 inclusive)
- Children in receipt of **benefits-related free school meals**
- **NEW for 2025:** Discretionary funded places are available for children in priority areas (this is often where schools have around 30% of pupils on benefits related free school meals) parents/carers can apply for a funded place, the HAF team will check the postcode and school of the child, and decide if a funded place will be granted.

This is **not a food voucher scheme** – all activities are delivered **face-to-face!**
